The balloon floats with enough helium inside it to lift 211,880 party balloons.



Seasonal restrictions: Open from May through end of October.




### Let's spread kindness!

The house was built in the mid-1820's and was part of a large farm on the northwest corner of 96th Street and Allisonville Road. It was later moved to this location once acquired by the City of Fishers.



Schoolhouse 7 Café



DID YOU KNOW? Schoolhouse 7 Café is located within a

historic schoolhouse that opened back in 1900.

During the 1930's, 10 subjects were taught by ONE teacher to 8 different classes at Schoolhouse 7.

There was no such thing as 2 hour delays or snow days. The kids went no matter the weather conditions.
